PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Veterinary Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jodi S. Bohl, D.V.M., (DOB February 17, 1956) is duly licensed as a veterinarian in the state of Wisconsin (license # 3951). This license was first granted on January 6, 1993.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board is N6790 865 St., Elk Mound, WI 54701.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a veterinarian at the Eau Claire Animal Hospital in Eau Claire, Wisconsin.
4. Respondent's license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Wisconsin expired on December 14, 2007. On February 25, 2009, Respondent was advised that she was not currently licensed and immediately stopped practicing. Respondent renewed her license on February 26, 2009. Respondent practiced veterinary medicine from

December 14, 2007 through February 25, 2009, while her license was expired.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 453.07(2), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. Practicing under an expired license constitutes a violation of Wis. Stats. 453.05(1) and Wis. Admin. Code § VE 7.06(20).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Jodi S. Bohl, D.V.M., is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, pay COSTS of this proceeding in the amount of ONE HUNDRED-FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150). Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

3. In the event Respondent fails to timely pay costs, as ordered, the Respondent's license (# 3951) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has paid them in full, including any accrued interest.
