On December 2, 2010, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for reinstatement of her registered nursing license which she surrendered pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated March 4, 2004. Based upon the length of time that petitioner has not practiced as a registered nurse, the Board now finds and makes the following:


ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petitioner's request for reinstatement of the registered nurse license of TINA P. PUTCHEL, R.N., (lic. # 127034-30) is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that before petitioner would be considered eligible for licensure, she shall complete a board-approved nursing program and pass the national licensure examination (NCLEX).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon successful completion of the educational and examination requirements for licensure, the Board reserves the right to impose additional substance abuse treatment and monitoring requirements which it may deem necessary for public safety and welfare.
