On May 6, 2010, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for full reinstatement of her practical nurse license which was suspended pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated July 29, 2004. The information presented shows that petitioner has satisfied the terms and conditions of the Board's Order, however, she has practiced nursing for an extended period of time. Based upon the information presented, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for full reinstatement of the registered nurse license of petitioner, DEBORAH L. DEGLOW, L.P.N., (lic. # 29614-31) is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner shall be granted a STAY OF SUSPENSION, for the sole purpose of completing an accredited LPN program. Petitioner shall not be allowed to accept employment as a nurse under the stay of suspension and may only use the license to complete the LPN program. Petitioner shall be required to renew her license by payment of the license renewal fees to obtain the benefit of the stay of suspension.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon acceptance into the LPN program, petitioner will be DENIED access to controlled substances and will be required to undergo random drug screens through a Board approved drug testing program. The frequency of the random

and alcohol screens through a Board approved drug testing program. The frequency of the random drug screens shall be forty-eight (48) times per year plus one annual hair test.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon successful completion of the LPN program, the Board reserves the right to impose additional limitations or requirements upon petitioner's license if necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare.


