The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on April 7, 2010.

BACKGROUND

On June 22, 2005, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order with regard to disciplinary proceedings against Ms. Timmerman, Pharmacist license #12694. Specifically, the conditions stated in paragraph C.21 provide that Ms. Timmerman may not be employed or work as a pharmacist in charge. Modifications to such Order are permitted pursuant to paragraph D.4 of such Order.

On or about March 10, 2010, Ms. Timmerman petitioned the Board to modify the Order by increasing the number of pharmacist in charge hours from the current twelve (12) hours to twenty (20) hours per week. The Respondent also requested permission to open and close a pharmacy consecutively.

Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ms. Timmerman's petition to increase the right to work as the pharmacist in charge to twenty (20) hours per week, be and hereby is, Granted.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to open and close a pharmacy consecutively, be and hereby is, Granted.
