The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on June 2, 2010.

BACKGROUND

On October 19, 2005, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order placing various conditions and limitations upon Mr. Kunde's license to practice as a pharmacist in the State of Wisconsin, Pharmacist license #8830. Specifically, paragraph C.22 prohibited the Respondent from working in the capacity of "pharmacist in charge". There have since been modifications to that order and at the time the Board considered this matter, Respondent was permitted to work 24 hours per week as "pharmacist in charge".

On or about, April 26, 2010, Mr. Kunde petitioned the Board to modify the Order increasing the right to work as the pharmacist in charge from twenty-four (24) hours to thirty-two (32) hours per week.

Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Mr. Kunde to increase the right to work thirty-two (32) hours per week as the pharmacist in charge, be and hereby is, Granted.
