The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on September 22, 2010.

BACKGROUND

On October 19, 2005, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order placing various conditions and limitations upon Mr. Kunde's license to practice as a pharmacist in the State of Wisconsin, Pharmacist license #8830. Specifically, paragraph C.14 requires drug and alcohol screenings at a frequency of not less than 96 times per year. There have since been modifications to that order and at the time the Board considered this matter, Respondent was required to submit to drug and alcohol screenings at a frequency of not less than 48 times per year.

On or about, September 1, 2010, Mr. Kunde petitioned the Board to modify the Order to reduce the number of drug and alcohol screenings per year.

Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Mr. Kunde's request to reduce the frequency of his drug and alcohol screenings, be and hereby is, Granted. Paragraph C.14 of the Final Decision and Order dated October 19, 2005 shall be revised to read as follows:

C.14. The Approved Program shall require the testing of urine specimens at a frequency of not less than fourteen (14) times per year. The frequency may only be further reduced up on a

determination by the Board or its designee after receiving a petition for modification as required by Paragraph D.4. of the Final Decision and Order.
