The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on July 28, 2010.

BACKGROUND

On December 6, 2006, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order adopting the Proposed Final Decision and Order of Administrative Law Judge William Dusso dated October 4, 2006. Such Decision suspended Mr. Moon's license to practice as a pharmacist in the State of Wisconsin, Pharmacist license #10536 and imposed a Suspension and Monitoring Order for Craig W. Moon.

Such Order specifically provided requirements for the granting of a stay of suspension, paragraph B.1. through B.5., and for drug and alcohol screens, paragraph C12. Through C18.

On or about May 20, 2010, Mr. Moon petitioned the Board requesting a stay of suspension and to modify the Order by accepting the drug and alcohol test results of the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey.

Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Respondent's petition for a stay of suspension, be and hereby is, Denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's request that the Board accept the drug and alcohol test results of the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey, be and hereby is, Denied.

Respondent needs to become compliant with all provisions of the Suspension and Monitoring Order, including drug and alcohol testing requirements, before the Board will consider whether to accept any past test results for tests performed by the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey.
