On February 25, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for full reinstatement of his registered nurse license which was voluntarily surrendered pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated March 12, 2008. Based upon the information presented the Board now finds and makes the following:

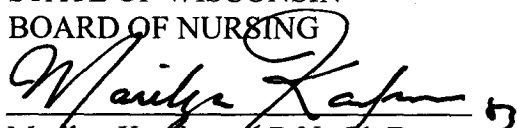
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for full reinstatement of the registered nurse license of KENNETH B. LANGE, JR., R.N. (lic. # 138752-30) is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner will be offered a standard impairment stipulation granting credit for two years of compliance in the state of Oklahoma. The terms of impairment order shall include urine drug screens twenty-eight (28) times per year with one additional hair test, and attendance at AA/NA meetings twice per week. In addition, petitioner will be required to provide quarterly work reports and abide by the Board's work setting restrictions, with access granted.
