On May 6, 2010, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for full reinstatement of her registered nurse license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated March 1, 2007. The information presented shows that petitioner has not satisfied the requirement of the Board order to complete a nurse refresher course. Based upon the information presented, the Board finds and makes the following:

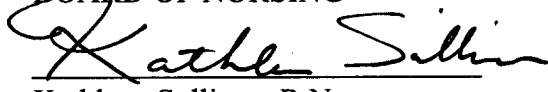
ORDER

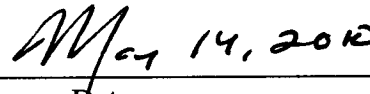
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for full reinstatement of the registered nurse license of petitioner, ANNE M. GRAF, R.N., (lic. # 93746-30) is hereby DENIED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner shall be granted a LIMITED license for the sole purpose of completing a Board-approved nurse refresher course. The limited license shall expire within one year from the date of issuance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that while completing the refresher course, petitioner will be required to undergo random drug screens through a Board approved drug testing program. The frequency of the random drug screens shall be fourteen (14) times per year plus one annual hair test.
