
On September 2, 2010, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modifications to the order of the Board dated February 28, 2008, to reduce her drug screens, decrease the AA meetings requirement and to modify her approved agency work-setting. Based upon the information of record which shows that petitioner has not been in compliance with the Board's order for the length of time necessary to warrant full approval of the modifications requested, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modifications to the limitations upon the license of JUDI L. OLSON, R.N. (lic. # 94686-30) is hereby GRANTED as to the frequency of her drug screens and her approved work-setting.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner's drug screens shall be decreased to a minimum of twenty-eight (28) per year plus one (1) annual hair test and that petitioner's approved work-setting is modified to allow her to work in additional sites within her agency, but petitioner may not work more than forty-five (45) hours per week. The request to decrease the required frequency of AA meetings is DENIED.
