The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on July 28, 2010.

BACKGROUND

On April 9, 2008, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Mr. Van Buren's license to practice as a pharmacist in the State of Wisconsin, Pharmacist license #12259, but immediately stayed that suspension subject to certain conditions. Specifically, paragraph C.14. requires urine screens for the presence of drugs and alcohol at a frequency of not less than 96 times per year.

In July, 2010, Mr. Van Buren petitioned the Board to modify the Order by reducing the frequency of drug and alcohol urine tests from 96 times per year to 72 times per year.

Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Respondent's petition to reduce the frequency of drug and alcohol urine tests, be and hereby is, Granted.

Paragraph C. 14 of the Final Decision and Order dated April 9, 2008 is changed to read as follows:

The Approved Program shall require the testing of urine specimens at a frequency of not less than 48 times per year. The Approved Program shall also require the testing of a hair

sample at a frequency of not less than 1 time per year. The frequency of such testing may be further reduced only upon a determination by the Board or its designee after receiving a petition for modification as required by D.4., below.

The effective date of this Order is April 7, 2010.
