
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for an extension of time to pay the costs assessed against Lou Ann Newby, R.N., (lic. #126237-30) is GRANTED. Petitioner shall have an additional 12 months to pay the full costs assessed in the disciplinary order. The extended time period for payment of costs shall begin on the effective date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner's stay of suspension shall be REMOVED based upon her non-compliance with the drug testing protocol. The Board or its designee may reinstate the stay pursuant to Paragraph B.4 of the November 5, 2009 order.
