


ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request by petitioner, KATHRYN M. BERRY, R.N. (lic. # 14859) for a decrease in her drug screens and termination of AA meetings is DENIED. The reduction in screens is denied on the basis of the positive screens. The termination of AA meetings is denied because it is an adjunct to recovery.

Petitioner is further advised that pursuant to paragraph C.4 of the Board's Order, her therapist may determine the frequency of the therapy sessions. The Board's approval is required only when the therapist is recommending complete termination of therapy.
