
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modifications to the limitations upon the registered nurse license of KELLY E. SCHLEUSENER, R.N. (lic. # 134371-30) is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner's drug screens shall be decreased to a minimum of twenty-eight (28) times per year with one (1) additional annual hair test. The frequency of petitioner's drug screens shall remain at this level for a period of three years before the Board will consider a request for reduction.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner's therapy shall be terminated based upon the recommendations of the treater.
