On April 28, 2010, the Wisconsin Psychology Examining Board considered the petitioner's request for reinstatement of his private practice school psychology license. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered his license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated August 19, 2010, due to his unprofessional conduct in regard to his completion of continuing education. Based upon the information presented, the Board now finds and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for full reinstatement of the license of TIMOTHY P. KABARA (lic. #875) to engage in the private practice of school psychology in the state of Wisconsin is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that only twenty (20) of the forty (40) hours of continuing education (CE) from *Ce4Less.com* for the 2005-2007 licensure biennium are accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner shall complete an additional pre-approved twenty (20) hours of CE for the 2006-2007 biennium from a curriculum and provider acceptable to the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner shall submit documentation of completion of the required CE for the 2007-2009 licensure biennium.

FINALLY, IT IS ORDERED that Petitioner is required to submit the following:

1) a written plan for completion for Board approval of all deficient CE hours for the prior bienniums and the current 2009-2011 biennium;

2) a new "nature of intended practice" form for the private practice of school psychology;

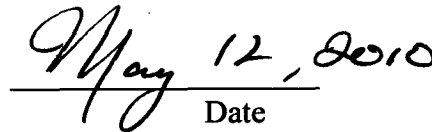
3) a scheduled personal appearance before the Board in support of the petition for reinstatement.
