On February 25, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request to decrease the frequency of her urine drug screens pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated July 23, 2009, because she is not working as a nurse. Based upon the evidence presented which shows that the petitioner is in compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the Board now finds and enters the following:


ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a decrease in the urine drug screens for SHERILL ROEDIGER, R.N., (lic.# 134561-30) is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner's drug screens shall be reduced to fourteen (14) per year, plus one additional hair test, until she returns to the active practice of nursing. Upon reemployment as a nurse, the petitioner's screens shall be increased to twenty-eight (28) per year with one additional hair test.
