On August 25, 2010, the Real Estate Appraisers Board filed its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the board ordered that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding be assessed against respondent. Pursuant to sec. RL 2.18 (4), Wis. Admin. Code, on or about August 30, 2010, the Real Estate Appraisers Board received the Affidavit of Costs in the amount of \$1,764.35, filed by Attorney Peter McCombs. On or about August 31, 2010, the Real Estate Appraisers Board received the Affidavit of Costs of the Division of Hearings and Appeals in the amount of \$122.00, filed by Administrative Law Judge Patrick T. Currie. The Real Estate Appraisers Board considered the Affidavits of Costs on November 10, 2010, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,886.35, set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney Peter McCombs and Administrative Law Judge Patrick T. Currie, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against respondent, and shall be payable by respondent to the Department of Regulation and Licensing. **Failure of respondent to make payment on or before December 10, 2010, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless respondent petitions for and the board grants a different deadline.** Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Regulation and Licensing may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the respondent until respondent has made payment to the department in the full amount assessed.





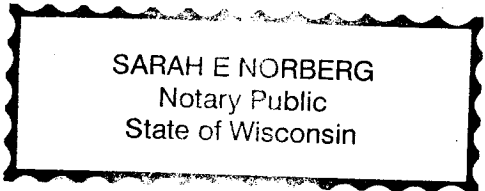
