The Real Estate Appraisers Board considered this matter at its meeting on August 25, 2010.

BACKGROUND

On October 13, 2009, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order with regard to disciplinary proceedings against Ms. Aylesworth, a Licensed Appraiser, License Number 4-1809. Specifically, the Board's order provided, in part, as follows:

- That the license of Rhonda R. Aylesworth is LIMITED. Prior to completing all steps in the application process for her license as a certified residential appraiser, Ms. Aylesworth must complete remedial education and complete no less than three appraisals for review.
- Ms. Aylesworth must complete 60 hours of remedial education as outlined in the order within one year of such order or prior to the issuance of a certificate of certification and licensure as a certified residential appraiser, whichever is earliest.
- That Ms. Aylesworth shall pay costs in the amount of \$725.00 within 6 months of the date of the order.
- That Ms. Aylesworth shall pay a forfeiture in the amount of \$1,000.00 within two years of the date of the order.

In June, 2010 Ms. Aylesworth petitioned the Board to remove the limitation on her license and grant her full licensure.

Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ms. Aylesworth's petition to remove the limitation on her license and grant her full licensure, be and hereby is, Granted.
