On June 3, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for a stay of the suspension of her registered nurse license and for modifications to the limitations upon her license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated December 3, 2009. Based upon the information of record, the petitioner has not been in compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order due to her lack of participation in an approved drug screen program, therefore, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER


NOW, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a stay of suspension registered nurse license of SAMANTHA BADER, R.N. (lic. # 140671-30) is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Board's Final Decision and Order shall be modified to require that petitioner shall comply with the following requirements:

1. Petitioner is required to enroll with Affinity, an approved drug testing program, for her random urinalysis screens.
2. Petitioner shall submit a hair specimen to the approved testing program for a hair sample drug screen.

3. Petitioner shall be permitted to pay the cost assessed against her in the disciplinary proceeding under an installment method because she is not working. Payment shall be reduced to \$25.00 per month until costs are paid in full.
