PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Pharmacy Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Alan J. Dickman, R.Ph., (DOB 11/16/1969) is duly licensed as a pharmacist in the state of Wisconsin (license # 40-14836). This license was first granted on December 28, 2006.

2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board is 4248 Braxton Drive, Janesville, Wisconsin, 53546.

3. Respondent is employed as a pharmacist at CVS Pharmacy # 8551.

4. On September 10, 2009, an investigator for the Department observed that the technician on duty was dispensing prescriptions to patients without a pharmacist consultation. Respondent was the pharmacist on duty.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §450.10, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph 4 above constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code §§ Phar 7.01(1)(e) and (em) and Phar 10.03(2) and subjects Respondent to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. §450.10(1)(a)2.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Alan J. Dickman, R.Ph. is REPRIMANDED.

2. Within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay a forfeiture of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

3. Within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).


5. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit any payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, or fails to pay costs as ordered, the Respondent's license (#
