PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Bradley R. Wolf, M.D. (DOB January 24, 1954), was duly licensed as a physician in the State of Wisconsin (#33924-20). This license was granted on November 19, 1992. This license expired on October 31, 2009.

- 2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board is 11877 Mason Road, Cincinnati, OH 45249.
- 3. On October 14, 2009, The State of Medical Board of Ohio issued a Step I Consent Agreement permanently revoking the license of Respondent. The revocation was stayed and Respondent's license was suspended for an indefinite period of time, but not less than one year from the effective date of the Step I Consent Agreement.
 - 4. Conditions of the Step I Consent Agreement include:
 - a. abstain completely from the use of drugs and alcohol
 - b. provide releases for treatment records
 - c. obtain permission from the Board for departures or absences from Ohio.
 - d. submit quarterly declarations and make an appearance before the Board on the third month following the effective date of the Order and every third month thereafter.
 - e. drug and alcohol screens
 - f. participate in an alcohol and drug rehabilitation program
 - 5. Respondent's medical license is currently inactive in Ohio.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. Respondent by having had disciplinary action taken against his Ohio license to practice medicine and surgery by the Medical Board of Ohio, as set out above, has committed unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § Med 10.02(2)(q) and is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The SURRENDER by Bradley R. Wolf, M.D., Respondent, of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin and his right to renew that license is hereby ACCEPTED.
 - 2. If Respondent ever makes application to the Board for any credential:

- a. He shall provide proof sufficient to the Board that he does not suffer from any alcohol or drug related condition or other psychological condition which impairs his ability to function as a physician.
- b. Whether to grant Respondent a credential and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any credential granted shall be in the sole discretion of the Board.
- c. Respondent shall, prior to becoming credentialed, pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$150.00 pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.22(2).
