PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. James T. Mansell (D.O.B. 10/17/58) is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a practical nurse (license # 303090). This license was first granted on 4/25/01.
2. By reason of permanent physical disability, Respondent is no longer able to practice nursing, and has not practiced nursing for at least 5 years.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The Board has jurisdiction of this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1)(c).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached Stipulation is ACCEPTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the SURRENDER of the license of James T. Mansell, L.P.N., to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin is ACCEPTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs of investigating and prosecuting this matter are WAIVED.
