PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing (Secretary). The Secretary has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Secretary in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about December 26, 2008, the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) received an application for licensure as a Certified General Appraiser from Chad H. Corliss, date of birth: 12/21/1967. Mr. Corliss' current address with the Department is 5608 Winnequah Trail, Monona, WI 53716. Mr. Corliss was licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a Real Estate Salesperson, license # 94-38762. This license was first granted to him on 03/04/1993 and it expired on 12/14/2008.

- 2. A standard application review was conducted of Mr. Corliss' application for a certified general appraiser license. As part of the application, Mr. Corliss submitted three appraisal work samples as part of his experience requirement.
- 3. A member of the Department's Real Estate Appraiser Application Advisory Committee (Committee) reviewed the work samples submitted by Mr. Corliss. On May 25, 2009, the reviewer recommended that the Department deny Mr. Corliss' application because his work samples did not comply with the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP), contrary to Wis. Stats. § 458.06 and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 83.01. On May 26, 2009, a Notice of Denial was sent to Mr. Corliss by certified U.S. mail. That letter was returned to the Department stamped "Unclaimed." The letter was re-sent by first class mail on June 23, 2009.
- 4. On or about July 6, 2009, Mr. Corliss made a timely request for a denial hearing. The request was subsequently granted.
- 5. After further review and receipt of the additional information from Mr. Corliss, the following conclusion has been reached. The issues identified by the Committee constitute minor USPAP violations, and do not warrant the continued denial of a license. The work sample errors were not egregious and real estate appraiser education in the subject matter of Income Approach, Sales Comparison Approach, Cost Approach, and land value analysis will adequately address the concerns noted in Mr. Corliss' work samples.
- 6. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Corliss consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 458.06, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Chad H. Corliss' hours of experience submitted as part of his application for a certified general appraiser license shall be accepted upon receipt and proof of successful completion of the following educational course:
 - a. Appraisal Institute's Residential Sales Comparison and Income Approaches (30 hour)
- 2. The Residential Sales Comparison and Income Approaches course may be taken on-line or in person and it must be completed within one (1) year from the date of this Order.
- 3. A certified general appraiser license shall be issued to Chad H. Corliss upon successful completion of ordered education and all other licensing requirements and payment of

fees associated with the credential. Mr. Corliss will not have to re-submit payment of any application fees that he has already paid for with respect to the application in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

4. File 10 APP 003 be, and hereby is, closed.
