PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Jeffrey Van Calligan (Date of Birth is May 21, 1960) is duly licensed by the Funeral Directors Examining Board as a Funeral Director in the state of Wisconsin (license number 77-4931). The license was first granted on July 22, 1991, and is current through December 14, 2011. The last address that Mr. Van Calligan reported to the Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) is Krause Funeral Home, 9000 West Capitol Drive, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53222.
- 2. Mr. Van Calliagn is employed by the Krause Funeral Home, 9000 West Capitol Drive, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53222, a licensed Funeral Establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license number 78-2256).

- 3. On one occasion in May 2008, Mr. Van Calligan prepared a body for a visitation. Mr. Van Calligan failed to follow the Krause Funeral Home identification of the deceased system and mistakenly placed the wrong body in the casket for the visitation.
- 4. In resolution of this matter, Jeffrey Van Calligan consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Sec. 445.13, Wis. Stat.
- 2. The Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 227.44(5)
- 3. By the action identified in Findings of Fact Number 3, Jeffrey Van Calligan has violated Wis. Admin. Code § FD 3.02(6) Any occurrence of the following shall constitute unprofessional conduct by a licensed funeral director, registered apprentice funeral director or owner of a funeral establishment,
 - (6) Providing and performing the services of funeral directing or embalming in a manner which falls below minimal standards established by statute, rule or practice in the profession.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jeffrey Van Calligan's license to practice as a Funeral Director in the state of Wisconsin (license number 77-4931) **is hereby REPRIMANDED.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jeffrey Van Calligan shall pay costs in the amount of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00) in this matter.

All payments shall be submitted within 180 days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by *certified check or money order*, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:
