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1. The Wisconsin Barber and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.08.
2. The Board has an obligation to protect the health and safety of Wisconsin consumers pursuant to *State v. Aldrich*, 71 Wis. 2d 206, 209 (1976).

ORDER

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, Exquisite Threading, be granted a Barber and Cosmetology Establishment License subject to the following Limitation:

1. Exquisite Threading may provide threading as a service, but may not provide any other barber and cosmetology service or any related services.
2. Only two employees may practice barbering and cosmetology in the establishment at a time.
3. The kiosk must remain in the same location in the mall.
