On May 19, 2010, the Real Estate Appraisers Board filed its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the board ordered that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding be assessed against respondent. Pursuant to sec. RL 2.18 (4), Wis. Admin. Code, on or about May 26, 2010, the Real Estate Appraisers Board received the Affidavit of Costs of the Division of Enforcement in the amount of \$381.79, filed by Attorney Angela Arrington. On or about June 8, 2010, the Real Estate Appraisers Board received the Affidavit of Costs of the Division of Hearings and Appeals in the amount of \$506.30, filed by Administrative Law Judge Amanda Tollefsen. The Real Estate Appraisers Board considered the Affidavits of Costs on November 10, 2010, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$888.09, set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney Angela Arrington and Administrative Law Judge Amanda Tollefsen, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against respondent, and shall be payable by respondent to the Department of Regulation and Licensing. Payment shall be due in the event that respondent seeks to renew or reinstate his license, or seeks to obtain any other license issued by the department. Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Regulation and Licensing may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the respondent until respondent has made payment to the department in the full amount assessed.
