On May 20, 2010, the Department of Regulation and Licensing filed its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the department ordered that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding be assessed against respondent. Pursuant to sec. RL 2.18 (4), Wis. Admin. Code, on or about June 2, 2010, the Department of Regulation and Licensing received the Affidavit of Costs of the Division of Enforcement in the amount of \$572.08, filed by Attorney Jeanette Lytle. On or about May 24, 2010, the Department of Regulation and Licensing received the Affidavit of Costs of the Division of Hearings and Appeals in the amount of \$488.00, filed by Administrative Law Judge Amanda Tollefsen. The Department of Regulation and Licensing considered the Affidavits of Costs on July 26, 2010, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,060.08, set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney Jeanette Lytle and Administrative Law Judge Amanda Tollefsen, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against respondent, and shall be payable by respondent to the Department of Regulation and Licensing. Failure of respondent to make payment on or before August 25, 2010, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless respondent petitions for and the department grants a different deadline. Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Regulation and Licensing may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the respondent until respondent has made payment to the department in the full amount assessed.
