On July 21, 2010, the Medical Examining Board (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order (Order) reprimanding Dr. Mark H. Decker and placing limitations on his license to practice medicine and surgery, including requiring 8 hours of education and paying \$2,500 in costs within 90 days of the date of the Order.

On or about September 28, 2010, Dr. Decker petitioned the Board to extend the time period to pay the \$2,500 in costs for another 6 months, and allow him to pay \$500 the first month and \$400 the following five months until the total amount of costs are paid in full. Based upon the information of record, the Board now finds and orders the following:

**ORDER**


**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that the request for a modification to extend the time period to pay \$2,500 in costs for 6 months of Mark H. Decker, M.D., (#20-26951) be and hereby is, GRANTED.

**IT IS FUTHER ORDERED** that the \$2,500 in costs may be paid in the following manner, \$500 the first month and \$400 the following five months until the total amount of costs is paid in full.
