PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Cinamon C. Hofman, R.N., Licensee, date of birth November 11, 1971, is licensed by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 120727, which was first granted July 28, 1995.
2. Respondent chose not to renew her license when it expired on February 28, 2010. For this reason, Respondent cannot legally practice nursing in Wisconsin at this time.
3. Licensee's last address reported to the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 5910 Ogden Avenue, Superior, WI 54880.
4. On June 29, 2007, Licensee suffered a head injury as a result of a fall.

5. Licensee has not worked as a nurse since the date of her fall. Licensee has advised the Division that her treating physicians have determined she is disabled and have restricted her from working as a nurse. It is unknown how long her physicians will restrict her from nursing. Licensee may desire to return to nursing when her physicians determine she is able to do so.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07.

2. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has authority to enter into this stipulated resolution of this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Cinamon C. Hofman, R.N., Licensee, is prohibited from renewing her license.

2. This prohibition shall continue until such time as Licensee petitions the Board and provides evidence sufficient to the Board that she does not suffer from any condition which impairs her ability to safely practice nursing.
