PROCEDURAL HISTORY

A disciplinary proceeding was commenced in this matter by the filing of a Notice of Hearing and Complaint with the Board on April 6, 2010. Prior to the hearing on the Complaint, the parties in this matter agreed to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lisa Jean Czub (dob: 11/12/62) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a practical nurse licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #24905-31. This license was first granted 6/3/82.

2. On 6/5/08, Respondent was arrested by a DNR park ranger for possession of marijuana and cocaine, and admitted using cocaine; she later admitted to an AODA assessor that she smoked marijuana occasionally but denied using cocaine. Respondent's arrest resulted in a deferred prosecution agreement, and she was not convicted of any offense. When the Board's investigator wrote to Respondent and inquired about this incident, Respondent did not respond in a timely

manner, and ultimately stated: "I have no history of drug usage nor do I have a history of possession of drugs." Respondent did not respond to a request for further information.

3. On 12/25/09, and while employed as a practical nurse at the Aspirus Pleasant View Nursing Home, Phillips, Wisconsin, Respondent appeared for her scheduled work shift at 6:40 AM, in an intoxicated condition, and refused to submit a sample of urine for testing. Respondent did not respond to a letter from Board staff, requesting an explanation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

A. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. 441.07(1)(b),(c), and (d), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. 227.44(5).

B. The conduct described in paragraph 2, above, violated Wis. Adm. Code \$ N 7.04(intro), (1), (2) and (15). The conduct described in paragraph 3, above, violated Wis. Stat. 441.07(1)(c) and Wis. Adm. Code \$ N 7.03(2) and N 7.04(intro). Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, effective the date of this Order, the SURRENDER of the license of Lisa J. Czub, L.P.N., to practice as a nurse in the State of Wisconsin is ACCEPTED. Respondent shall not practice nursing in Wisconsin, including under the Nurse Licensure Compact, without a license from the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the costs of this matter are \$1,900, and are waived, but if Respondent ever seeks licensure, she may be required to pay them at that time.
