The Petition for Summary Suspension of September 24, 2010, noticed to be presented at 10:30 a.m. on October 14, 2010, came on for hearing before the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board) at the time and place noticed. Attorney Jeanette Lytle appeared for the Complainant, Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement. Neither the Respondent, Selena L. Williams, L.P.N., nor any representative of Respondent appeared on her behalf.

The Board having considered the sworn affidavits of paralegal Beth Cramton regarding service; the sworn Petition for Summary Suspension; the August 9, 2010 notarized letter of Tomina Schaefer-Trower, R.N.; the licensure information for Selena L. Williams. and Selena Patricia Hollman; the Board Order suspending the license of Selena Patricia Hollman; and the criminal history for Selena LaCrickett Hollman; and, having heard the arguments of counsel, hereby makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 27, 2010, Paralegal Beth Cramton served on Respondent the Notice of Petition for Summary Suspension, dated September 24, 2010, and the Petition for Summary suspension, dated September 24, 2010, by mailing a true and accurate copy of those documents by regular mail and certified mail.
2. On October 4, 2010, Paralegal Beth Cramton served on Respondent the Notice of Hearing and Complaint, dated October 4, 2010, by mailing a true and accurate copy of those documents by regular mail and certified mail.
3. Selena L. Williams L.P.N., Respondent, date of birth August 13, 1961, is licensed by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing as a practical nurse pursuant to license number 31-303599, which was first granted February 7, 2002.
3. Respondent's last address reported to the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 4575 N. 46th St., Milwaukee, WI 53218.
4. DOE case number 10 NUR 236 was opened based on a complaint from Respondent's former employer. In June of 2010, Respondent's employer ran a criminal

background check, and discovered multiple criminal offenses relating to prostitution and illegal drugs under the name Selena Lacrickett Hollman, date of birth August 13, 1961. Selena L. Williams was listed as a known alias of Selena Lacrickett Hollman. The criminal background check contained a photograph of Selena Lacrickett Hollman, which the employer's director of nursing recognized to be the woman she knew as Selena L. Williams.

5. Respondent had not reported these convictions to the Board as required.

6. Respondent's employer checked the Department of Regulation and Licensing website, and discovered that Selena Patricia Hollman (date of birth August 13, 1961) held a nursing license (# 31-28760), which was suspended in 1995. Selena Patricia Hollman is another known alias of Selena Lacrickett Hollman.

7. In 2002, when Respondent applied for a new LPN license in the State of Wisconsin (through endorsement by Minnesota), Respondent did not disclose that she held an LPN license under another name, that was suspended. Therefore, Respondent currently has two LPN license numbers in the State of Wisconsin.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07.

2. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has authority to summarily suspend a license to practice nursing pursuant to §§ 227.53(3), Stats., and Wis. Adm. Code § RL 6.

3. There is probable cause to believe that Respondent has engaged in or is likely to engage in conduct such that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively requires emergency suspension of Respondent's license to practice nursing.

ORDER


IT IS ORDERED that the license of Selena L. Williams, L.P.N., to practice nursing in the state of Wisconsin is summarily suspended, effective immediately upon Respondent receiving actual notice of this summary order or upon service of this summary suspension order upon Respondent under § RL 6.06(3), Wis. Adm. Code, whichever is sooner.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order continues to be in effect until the effective date of a final order and decision in the pending disciplinary proceeding against Respondent, unless otherwise ordered by the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent is hereby notified of her right, pursuant to Wis. Adm. Code § RL 6.09, to request a hearing to show cause why this summary suspension order should not be continued and is further notified that any request for a hearing to show cause should be filed with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing, 1400 East Washington Avenue, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event that Respondent requests a hearing to show cause why the summary suspension should not be continued, that hearing shall be scheduled to be heard on a date within 20 days of receipt by the Board of Respondent's request for hearing, unless Respondent requests or agrees to a later time for the hearing.
