
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for an extension of the training license of KELVIN C. HOGANS (lic. #35-226) to practice as licensed professional counselor is GRANTED subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Proof of completion of 30 CEUs prior to the expiration of extended training license.
2. Practice under the supervision of a supervisor approved by the section.
3. The term of the extension shall be until August 16, 2012.
