PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Wisconsin Board of Nursing found probable cause, based upon the evidence presented in the Petition for Summary Suspension, filed in the matter of disciplinary proceedings against Michael L. Raymond, RN, (Case No. 10 NUR 371), to believe that respondent has engaged in, or is likely to engage in, conduct such that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively requires emergency suspension of the respondent's license. Accordingly, on November 4, 2010, the Board issued an order granting the petition for summary suspension of the respondent's license to practice nursing until the effective date of a final order and decision in the pending disciplinary matter.

On November 8, 2010, a request was filed by the respondent's attorney pursuant to Wis. Admin. RL 6.09, for a hearing to show cause why the summary suspension should not be continued until the effective date of the final decision and order in the disciplinary matter.

On November 16, 2010, the Board held a teleconference meeting to consider the respondent's request for a show cause hearing. The Board considered 1) whether to grant the request for a hearing, pursuant to RL 6.09, and 2) whether to make a designation pursuant to Wis. Admin. RL 6.11(a) for the presiding over and ruling in the matters raised at the hearing to show cause. Based upon the information of record and the procedures set forth in RL 6.11, the Board now issues the following:

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the request for a Showing Cause hearing in the Matter of the Summary Suspension of Michael L. Raymond, RN, (lic. # 150051-30) is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an employee of the Department of Regulation and Licensing, is hereby designated to preside over the hearing to show cause. The Board also delegates to the designated employee of the Department the authority to rule in the hearing to show cause on behalf of the Board.
