On June 2, 2011, the Monitor presented to the Board of Nursing for consideration a possible violation of the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated July 7, 2000. Based upon the information of record which shows Mary Lou Still Church is not in compliance with the drug testing and therapy requirements, the Board now finds and makes the following:



ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the extension of the stay is DENIED and the registered nurse license of Mary Lou Still Church, R.N. (#66773-30) reverts to SUSPENDED status.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mary Lou Still Church may request, within 45 days of the date of this Order, an opportunity for a hearing in accordance with the procedures set forth in ch. RL 1, Wis. Admin. Code pursuant to the Final Decision and Order dated July 7, 2000. The request shall include a specific description of the mistake in fact or law which constitutes reasonable grounds for reversing the decision to deny the extension of the stay. If a mistake in fact is asserting, the request shall include a concise statement of the essential facts which Ms. Still Church intends to prove at the hearing.
