The following Order was issued per the October 1, 2009 motion of the Board of Nursing. The record is ambiguous as to whether service by mail was effectuated due to change in Petitioner's address.

Therefore, the Board reissues the following:

On October 1, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for full reinstatement of her licensed practical nurse license which had been suspended pursuant to the Order of the Board dated January 20, 2004, and previously limited by the March 7, 2003 Final Decision and Order of the Board. Based upon the information presented showing that the petitioner has completed the continuing education required under the 2003 Order, the Board now finds and makes the following:



ORDER
