On October 6, 2011, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for a stay of suspension of her registered nurse license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated July 29, 2004. Petitioner's stay of suspension was removed on March 8, 2011, due to her failure to comply with the drug testing requirements under the order. In addition to consideration of petitioner's request for a stay of suspension, the Board received a report from the department monitor concerning a petitioner's on-going violation of the terms and conditions of the order for non-compliance with the drug screen testing protocol. Based upon all of the information presented, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a stay of suspension of the registered nurse of SHERRY L. WARD, R.N. (lic. #68922-30) is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner shall have three (3) months successful compliance with the Board order prior to submitting a petition for a stay of suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner may request, within 45 days of the date of this Order, an opportunity for a hearing in accordance with the procedures set forth in ch. RL 1, Wis. Admin. Code. The request for a hearing shall include a specific description of the mistake in fact or law which constitutes reasonable grounds for reversing the decision to deny the extension of the stay. If a mistake in fact is asserting, the request shall include a concise statement of the essential facts which petitioner intends to prove at the hearing.

This order is effective 5 days from the date signed below to allow for receipt of the order by mail.
