ORDER DENYING REINSTATMENT

HOLLY R. (GERSTL) STILLER, RN : RN REFRESHER COURSE

PETITIONER :

On November 3, 2011, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for reinstatement of her surrendered registered nurse license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated December 8, 2005. Based upon the information of record, including the psychological evaluation dated March 21, 2011, the Board now finds and makes the following:

#### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for reinstatement of full licensure status of the registered nurse license of Holly R. Stiller, R.N. (#131634-30) is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the registered nurse license of Holly R. Stiller, RN (#131634-30) is REINSTATED and LIMITED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING A BOARD APPROVED RN REFRESHER COURSE. Ms. Stiller has one year from the date of this Order to successfully complete the RN refresher course. If the refresher course is not completed within one year, the limited license will expire.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERD THAT the license is additionally LIMITED as follows:

- Ms. Stiller shall <u>not</u> work in a position which requires nursing licensure under this limited license. This limited license is for the *sole* purpose of completing clinicals as an educational requirement of the RN refresher course.
- Ms. Stiller shall provide a copy of this Order, her Board Orders dated September 16, 2004 and December 8, 2005 and the psychological evaluation done by Dr. David DuBord dated March 21, 2011 to the school and all clinical sites.
- Following completion of the RN refresher course, Ms. Stiller shall arrange for the submission from the school of an evaluation report regarding classroom and clinical performance to the Department Monitor.

- Ms. Stiller shall comply with the therapy recommendations as outlined by Dr. David DuBord in the psychological evaluation dated March 21, 2011. She shall arrange for the submission of quarterly therapy reports to the Department Monitor.
- Ms. Stiller shall participate in an approved drug and alcohol monitoring program. The
  frequency of drug and alcohol screens shall be not less than 48 times per year urine screens and
  one annual hair screen. A list of approved programs is available from the Department Monitor.
  Failure to comply with all requirements for participation in drug and alcohol monitoring
  established by the approved program is a violation of the Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT upon successful completion of the RN refresher course, the Board may in its sole discretion determine whether and under what terms and conditions further licensure may be granted.
