ORDER DENYING EXTENSION
OF THE STAY AND
DENYING MODIFICATION

On May 5, 2011, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request to remove the word "limited" from her licensure status and the information brought forth by the Department Monitor of a possible a violation of the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated January 27, 2005. The Department Monitor presented information regarding a termination from employment for providing personal phone number to a patient, transportation of a patient in her personal vehicle and erroneously reporting TB test result by writing up the results before she read the results. In addition, the testing reports indicate that Petitioner has not enrolled in Affinity for drug screens pursuant to Order dated October 22, 2010. Based upon the information of record which indicates that the petitioner is not safe to practice, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the extension of the stay is DENIED and the registered nurse license of Anita Jones, R.N. (#126154) reverts to SUSPENDED status.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Anita Jones may petition for a stay after she demonstrates three months of compliance with the Order, including enrollment with Affinity for drug testing, and provides a fitness to practice evaluation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Anita Jones may request, within 45 days of the date of this Order, an opportunity for a hearing in accordance with the procedures set forth in ch. RL 1, Wis. Admin. Code pursuant to the Final Decision and Order dated January 27, 2005. The request shall include a specific description of the mistake in fact or law which constitutes reasonable grounds for reversing the decision to deny the extension of the stay. If a mistake in fact is asserting, the request shall include a concise statement of the essential facts which Ms. Jones intends to prove at the hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for the word "limited" to be moved from the license status of the registered nurse license of Anita Jones, R.N. (#126154) is DENIED as it accurately reflects the legal status of her license per the Board Orders.
