The Dentistry Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on January 5, 2011.

BACKGROUND

On May 3, 2006, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order which included, among others, the suspension of the respondent's dentistry license, license number 3392. A stay of suspension was immediately granted to the respondent in 2006 allowing the respondent to continuing working as a dentist in accordance with all other terms and conditions of the Final Decision and Order. There have been multiple subsequent modifications to the Final Decision and Order.

In December 2010, it was brought to the Dentistry Examining Board's attention that the respondent had consumed alcohol and was in violation of the Final Decision and Order.

Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stay of suspension previously granted is hereby removed and the respondent's license is immediately SUSPENDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED as follows:

The respondent shall submit to drug and alcohol testing at a frequency of not less than 52 times per year. Paragraph 13 of the Final Decision and Order of May 3, 2006 shall be modified to read as follows:

13. Unless otherwise ordered by the Board, the Approved Program shall require the testing of urine specimens at a frequency of not less than 52 times per year.

The respondent shall be in full compliance with the Final Decision and Order as amended for a minimum of three (3) months before petitioning the Board for any modification to said order, including a stay of the suspension.
