On January 27, 2011, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for a modification of the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated September 4, 2008, to reduce the frequency of her drug screens. Petitioner was scheduled to appear before the Board, but failed to do so and sent insubordinate e-mail correspondence to the Department in regard to her appearance and drug testing compliance. Based upon the information of record which shows that the petitioner has not been in compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request to reduce the frequency of the drug screens for PAULA M. SALKIN, R.N., (lic. # 84037-30) is hereby DENIED.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner shall not petition or appear before the Board for any reason prior to demonstrating three months of compliance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Order requires petitioner to complete drug screens and that she is required to complete her testing on the date she is notified.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that further insubordination and non-compliance on the part of the petitioner provides cause for the Board to consider the need for a psychological assessment.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date signed to allow for mailing.
