On November 3, 2011, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modification to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated September 4, 2008 to reduce the frequency of therapy sessions, drug screens and AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record which shows compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

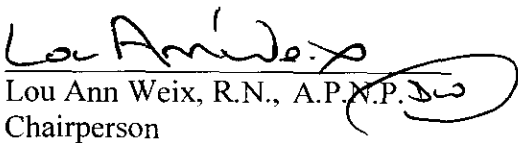
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Kathryn M. Berry, R.N. (#148959-30) to reduce the frequency of drug testing to at least 28 times per year urine screens and an annual hair test is GRANTED.

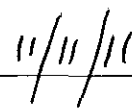
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the modification to reduce the frequency of AA/NA meetings is DENIED because it is an adjunct to recovery.

Petitioner is further advised that pursuant to paragraph C.4 of the Board's Order, her therapist may determine the frequency of the therapy sessions. The Board's approval is required only when the therapist is recommending termination of therapy.
