On July 21, 2011, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for reinstatement of her revoked registered nurse license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated February 26, 2009. Based upon the information of record which shows insufficient evidence to convince the Board she has been abstinent for at least one year immediately preceding her application for reinstatement and that she has not completed at least 56 random drug screens, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for reinstatement of the registered nurse license of Hedy Klinger, R.N. (#114342-30) is DENIED.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the number of drug screens required to be completed to demonstrate at least one year of abstinence shall be decreased to 48 urine drug screens and 1 hair test.
