On April 15, 2009, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order indefinitely suspending the license to practice medicine and surgery of Charles E. Nelson, M.D., (#20-38077) but imposed an immediate stay contingent upon Dr. Nelson's compliance with terms and conditions specified in the Order. Condition C.14 specified the frequency of testing specimens for drug screening. On April 12, 2010, the Board reduced the number of drug screens to thirty (30) times per year.

On or about April 5, 2011, the petitioner requested a further reduction in drug screens from thirty (30) times per year to twenty (20) times per year. Based upon the information of record presented, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limited license of Charles E. Nelson, M.D., (#20-38077) to reduce the number of drug screen frequency from thirty (30) times per year to twenty (20) times per year, be and hereby is, GRANTED.
