On November 10, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing granted Respondent an initial stay of the suspension of her nursing license, (#54444-30), pursuant to the Board Order dated November 10, 2009 ("Order"). The Order provided that the stay is continuous contingent upon her compliance with the terms and conditions under the Order.

Information has been received by the Department Monitor that Respondent is in violation of the Board's Order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stay of suspension is REMOVED and Judith A. Mueller's registered nurse license (#54444-30) is SUSPENDED for an indefinite period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent may petition the Board for a stay of suspension upon demonstrating to the satisfaction of the Board or its designee that Respondent has been in compliance with the provisions of Sections C and D of this Order for the most recent three (3) consecutive months.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
