The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on October 26, 2011.

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

On January 13, 1999, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order that included, among other limitations, the suspension of Roger G. Iverson's Pharmacist license, number 8239-40. Based thereon, the Board makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On January 13, 1999, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Mr. Iverson's license to practice as a pharmacist in the state of Wisconsin, license number 8239-40. The Order permitted a stay of suspension, subject to certain conditions. There have been multiple modifications to this Order over the intervening years.

2. On October 4, 2010, the Board issued an Order Denying Modification and Revoking Stay of Suspension, which revoked a stay of suspension previously granted to Mr. Iverson due to Mr. Iverson being out of compliance with the Final Decision and Order of January 13, 1999 by having a positive drug screen and by his subsequent admission to the consumption of a controlled substance. The Board further ordered that Mr. Iverson be in complete compliance with the Final Decision and Order of January 13, 1999 for a period of three months before petitioning the Board for a stay of suspension. Section 5 of the January 13, 1999 Order requires a petition to be accompanied by a written recommendation from his supervising physician or therapist in support of the petition.

3. On or about April 13, 2011, Mr. Iverson petitioned the Board to modify the Final Decision and Order dated January 13, 1999 by requesting a stay of the suspension.

4. On June 16, 2011, the Board issued an Order Denying Stay due, in part, to the lack of a supporting letter from Mr. Iverson's therapist.

5. On September 23, 2011, Mr. Iverson petitioned the Board to modify the Final Decision and Order dated January 13, 1999 by requesting a stay of the suspension.

6. On October 26, 2011, the Board reviewed Mr. Iverson's petition and all of the information of record, including a supporting letter from Mr. Iverson's therapist.

7. On October 26, 2011, the Board determined that Mr. Iverson was in compliance with the terms of the Final Decision and Order dated January 13, 1999, the Order Denying Modification and Revoking Stay of Suspension dated October 4, 2010, and the Order Denying Stay dated June 16, 2011. As a result, the Board granted Mr. Iverson's petition for a stay of suspension. Based upon all the information of record, the Board finds that the Orders below are necessary to ensure the safety and protection of the public, and orders the following:

### ORDER

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that the suspension of Roger G. Iverson's license to practice pharmacy (number 8239-40) is STAYED effective immediately.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all other terms and conditions of the January 13, 1999 Final Decision and Order shall remain in effect as set forth in that Order.

Roger G. Iverson shall be in full compliance with this Order and the Final Decision and Order dated January 13, 1999 as amended.
