On February 10, 2010, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board limited Respondent's license as a Barbering and Cosmetology Practitioner because she failed to notify the Department within 48 hours of the entry of a judgment of conviction against her. The Board required Respondent to comply with numerous conditions during the pendency of its February 10, 2010 Order. The Board's Order further stated that Respondent could petition for full reinstatement of her license upon her release from the probation term that resulted from her criminal conviction.

On March 12, 2011, Respondent petitioned the Board to grant full reinstatement of her license. Based on the Department Monitor's report, the Board finds that Respondent has fully complied with the conditions imposed in the Board's February 10, 2010 Order. For that reason, the board grants Respondent's request.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations placed on Respondent's license as a Barbering and Cosmetology Practitioner (# 82-85873) in the February 10, 2010 Order are removed. Her license is hereby reinstated to full and unrestricted status.
