

On September 1, 2011, the Monitor presented to the Board of Nursing for consideration a possible violation of the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated May 6, 2010. Based upon the information of record which shows a violation of the Board Order due to failure to comply with a drug screen request, the Board now finds and makes the following:
