On October 6, 2011, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modification to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated July 22, 2010 to reduce the frequency of drug screens. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stay of suspension is REMOVED and Laura Daus' registered nurse license (#110830-30) reverts to SUSPENDED status.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request of modification is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a petition for a stay shall not be considered until there is at least three months of compliance with the Order. The petition for a stay shall include a current fitness to practice evaluation.
