Please take notice that under the authority of Wis. Stat. Chapters 227 and 444 and Wis. Admin. Code Chapters 192 to 196, the Department of Regulation and Licensing makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Tyler Hellenbrand is licensed as a professional Mixed Martial Artist in Wisconsin with license 54-277.
- 2. Hellenbrand participated in the Combat USA tournament, held on January 6, 2011. This event was held at Oneida Bingo and Casino, in Green Bay Wisconsin.
- 3. Hellenbrand suffered a laceration of his right eye due to an illegal up-kick, at 1:22 Seconds of Round 2, which resulted in a win by disqualification as determined by the referee.
- 4. The physician stated that Hellenbrand would need to be seen by a physician to be cleared to compete.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. By suffering this laceration, as described in finding of fact 3, Hellenbrand is subject to a new mandatory medical evaluation before being able to compete in Mixed Martial Arts as required by Wis. Admin. Code sec. RL 196.02.
- 2. The department has jurisdiction to take disciplinary action pursuant to Wis. Stat. Chaps. 227 and 444 and Wis. Admin. Code Chaps. 192 to 196.
- 3. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code sec. RL 196.02 (3) and (4) a medical suspension shall not be cleared by the department until a contestant complies with all post-bout medical examination requirements.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the licensee of Mr. Tyler Hellenbrand is suspended for the mandatory period of 30 days, effective January 6, 2011 through February 5, 2011 as required by Wis. Admin. Code sec. RL 196.02.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the medical suspension of the license of Mr. Hellenbrand may not be cleared by the department until after a medical examination is conducted and Mr. Hellenbrand is cleared to compete.
