**ORDER OF
SUMMARY SUSPENSION**

Division of Enforcement Cases #09 NUR 393, 09 NUR 223, 09 NUR 243

This matter came before the Board at its regular and properly noticed meeting on January 27, 2011. The appearances were Arthur Thexton, Prosecuting Attorney; there was no appearance by or on behalf of Respondent. The Board received the sworn Petition, a copy of a criminal complaint, a copy of a prescription, and two maps, and heard a statement by the Prosecuting Attorney.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Monique Renee Bradley (dob: 7/11/77) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a professional nurse licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #154871. This license was first granted 7/16/07. Respondent's address of record is 8921 W. Courtland Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53225-4909.
2. There is probable cause to believe that the allegations of the Petition are true.
3. One reasonable inference to draw from the allegations of the Petition is that Respondent is diverting opioids to another, for unprescribed use.
4. Diversion of opioids is an immediate danger to the public. Summary suspension is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare.
5. Another reasonable inference to draw from the allegations of the Petition are that Respondent is consuming unprescribed opioids.
6. For Respondent to practice while influenced by an unprescribed opioid is an immediate danger to patients and the public. Summary suspension is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare.
7. A formal Complaint alleging that Respondent has committed unprofessional conduct has been filed.
8. Respondent was informed of this Notice and Petition for Summary Suspension on 12/22/10, by having the documents mailed to her address of record, and e-mailed to her attorney in the Waukesha County criminal matter, on that date. A certified mail receipt was received from the postal service, bearing Respondent's signature, for the envelope containing the Notice and Petition for Summary Suspension, and the formal Complaint and Notice of Hearing.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The legal requirements for summary suspension pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.51(3) and Wis. Adm. Code ch. RL 6, have been met.


ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: the license of Monique R. Bradley, R.N., to practice nursing is **SUSPENDED** pending a final decision and order in this matter. Respondent shall surrender her credentials to the Board, or any department staff requesting them, forthwith.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent may request a hearing to show cause why this suspension order should not be continued, and may file such request with the Administrative Law Judge assigned to this matter, at Division of Hearings and Appeals, 5005 University Avenue #201, P.O. Box 7875, Madison, WI 53707-7875. A hearing on such request shall be scheduled within 20 days of the date the ALJ receives such request, unless Respondent agrees to a later date.
